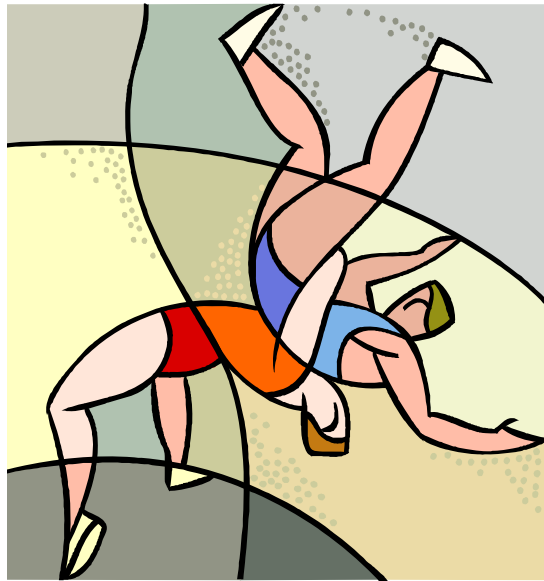

ENTRY FEE FOR WRESTLERS:

1 style = \$15 if the wrestler decides to sign-up for more than one style of wrestling it will cost an additional \$10 for each style.

2 styles = \$25 and so on

PRE-REGISTRATION:

Michigan USA Wrestling strongly urges all wrestlers to utilize the link on MUSAW to complete pre-registration for all weight classes and styles. Go to the website musaw.org at which time you will link to register. **The link will start May 3rd and last till May 13th.** If you experience any problems with your on-line registration please call Jon Hayden 1-269-876-9059 and / or Marcy Felice @ 1-517-899-0829.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION

There will also be on-site registration for those wrestlers who are unable to pre-register on-line. However, expect possible wait time in line.

ADMISSION FEE:

Toddlers/Infants age 4 and under and Senior Citizens 65+ = free
Children 5-12 = \$3 Daily or \$5 for weekend
Adults = \$10 daily or \$15 for weekend.

MAT SIDE:

ONLY TWO PEOPLE AT THE CORNER OF THE MAT.

HEADGEAR:

Recommended for younger wrestlers, however OPTIONAL

SINGLET:

A red or blue singlet is required for State. Any red or blue singlet will suffice. It does not have to be a reversible singlet. The singlet, whether it is reversible or one red and one blue, must be at least 60% red or 60% blue.

WEIGH - INS:

All wrestlers must weigh in wearing a "competition" singlet - not a singlet with the straps cut off or with shorts on, a "competition" singlet. This will allow the trainer doing the skin check to see the athlete's body. Once a wrestler has entered the weigh-in area you will not be able to leave until completing your weigh-in. Also, a wrestler will be able to step on to the scale one time. If the weight is disputed there will be another scale for a second weigh-in. That is the final weight check.

COACHING MAT SIDE / FLOOR PASS: **OPTIONS #1 AND #2**

OPTION #1: Coaches/Parents with a Copper Certification Card or higher, USA Coaching Card and identification in their name will **pay \$5** dollars and receive a lanyard with see through badge. All materials listed above are to be placed into the badge along with the coach's pass.

OPTION #2: If you are unable to receive a coach's card and /or a Copper Card or higher there will be **mat side / floor pass at a one time fee of \$35** for the tournament with a lanyard and see through badge. This is also for the people that want to go onto the floor and video tape/ take pictures = \$35.

YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ONTO THE MAT SIDE OR FLOOR WITHOUT DOING ONE OF THE LISTED OPTIONS #1 OR #2 ABOVE.

SOME COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1) **Qualifications for wrestlers to participate in the MUSAW State Meet are as follows:** Due to time constraints and some confusion with the weight classes required to attend 2 events only Wrestlers Pee-wee thru Schoolboy/Girl have to participate in 2 events. Events are as follows at least two MUSAW Events in state and/or two USA Events out of state. Wrestlers have to place in the top 6. Cadet thru Masters does not have to qualify for the State Meet. No matter if a wrestler goes up or down in weight classes has no bearing on the two qualifying tournaments. Also, if on one event your wrestler does Greco then the next event he/she does just Freestyle that counts for two events.

SOME COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

2) Scratch weight for all weight classes - **NO WEIGHT ALLOWANCES.**

3) If you weigh-in on Friday and wrestle Greco Kids (Pee-Wee thru Schoolboy/girl) you do not have to weigh-in for Freestyle on Saturday.

4) If you weigh-in Saturday for Cadet / Junior Greco Wrestling you do not have to weigh-in for Freestyle on Sunday.

5) Weigh-in times, locations, concessions, vendors, awards table, etc will be clearly marked.

6) Again coaches / parents wishing to enter onto the mat side will need at minimum a Copper Card, a USA Coaches Card and / or a weekend pass for \$35.

7) When checking in for wrestling and you are doing both Greco and Freestyle please fill out two weight slips.

8) Can a Cadet thru Masters who has never wrestled at a MUSAW wrestle at the State Meet =YES! Cadets thru Masters do not have to qualify to wrestle. They will be required to buy a USA Wrestling Card.

9) **NO ONE CAN BE ON THE FLOOR OR MAT SIDE WITHOUT A PASS.**

10) Parking will be located in the front parking lot off Grand River at Howell High School.

MAY 14TH - FRIDAY:

Time: 3:30pm to 5pm Check-in will occur in the Howell High School Cafeteria for weight classes Pee-Wee to Schoolboy/girl Greco Wrestling and Women's Freestyle. **Weigh-ins** and skin checks will be located in the Howell Field house.

Check -in and weigh-ins for working officials will also occur at the same time 3:30pm to 5pm. Check with Lance Wager Head Official.

The National Anthem will be sung at 6pm by Tim O'Leary followed by wrestling.

These are the groups wrestling:

- 1) Pee-wee thru Schoolboy/girl Greco
- 2) Women's Freestyle

****IF YOU ARE ALSO PARTICIPATING IN KIDS FREESTYLE ON SATURDAY THIS WEIGH-IN WILL COVER THAT WRESTLER.****

MAY 15TH - SATURDAY:

Time: 7am to 8am Check-in will occur in the Howell High School Cafeteria for weights Pee-wee thru Schoolboy/girl Freestyle. **Weigh-ins** and skin checks will be located in the Howell Field house.

11am to 12 noon Check-in and weigh-ins for Cadet / Junior Greco Wrestling and Open-Masters Greco / Freestyle Wrestling

****Registration and weigh-ins for working officials will also occur at 7am to 8am.**

Wrestling will begin after weigh-ins. These are the groups wrestling:

- 1) Pee-wee thru Schoolboy/girl Freestyle
- 2) Cadet and Junior Greco
- 3) Open and Masters Greco / Freestyle

MUSAW Director Dan Coon will address the State Meet along with introducing the Board of Director's. The National Anthem will follow being sung by Tim O'Leary.

MAY 16TH - SUNDAY:

Time: 7am to 8am Check-in will occur in the Howell High School Cafeteria and weigh-ins for Cadet and Junior Freestyle will occur in the Howell Field house.

Once weigh-ins are completed wrestling will soon follow.

IF YOU OR SOMEONE IN YOUR CLUB IS CAUGHT SWAPPING COACHES PASSES AND / OR WEEKEND PASSES THEY WILL **BE** CONFISCATED WITH NO REFUND AND THE PERSONS INVOLVED WILL BE ESCORTED OFF GROUNDS.
